

## Supply List and information for participants

Oaxaca Art Travel Journal Workshop - January 2027

During the workshop we will be creating our own collage materials and papers to include in our journals. You will create two handmade journals (one for this trip and another for your next one!) We will also work together to create focal points that you will keep in your stash to add to your journal pages while you're art journaling in various locations through the week.

### Supplies for participants to bring

- Hback books:
  - At least two hback books or book covers to use as your art journal cover (repurposing usually a vintage book cover). You can remove the text block ahead of time if you are looking to save on weight when packing.
  - Your books should be approximately 8 inches tall and 5 inches wide (ok if slightly larger or smaller). The spine of the book should be at least one inch wide/thick.
  - A book to use as your companion journal. This one can be any size. It should lay flat when opened. Ideal if it has images in it (but not absolutely required). It will be the place you will put your extra paint and collage paper.
  - Sources to find these books: Thrift store, estate sale, flea market, used bookstore, recycling bin near a book donation area.
  - If you have any questions, please feel free to contact us!
- Pages to use for your 'junk' journal - blank or printed paper, paper torn from coffee table books, catalogues, magazines, old books, advertisements, ledger paper, scrapbook paper, etc. (your journal will use approximately 20 pages). If you have gelli prints, these will make great papers to use in your journal. We will be tearing them down to approximately letter sized papers. We will be working with mixed media to add layers to these pages.
- 10-15 pieces of thin/translucent paper such as deli paper, wet-strength tissue paper, vellum, etc.
- 15 pages of Drawing or mixed media paper (11 x 14 or 12 x 18 inches) of your choice
- A few small bottles of acrylic paint in colors that you like
- An 8 oz bottle of matte medium (liquid or gel, your preference)
- Old gift cards or key cards to use for scraping paper
- Brushes - a basic acrylic paint brush set is fine, 0,2,4,6,8, some flat (½ inch and 1 inch) and some round. (nothing fancy) (acrylic paint).
- Store bought or handmade stencils with patterns
- Apron

### Your travel journaling kit- supplies to bring

Basic items:

- Journal
- Waterproof, zippered bag to hold your supplies

- Collage materials (we will make these together, but you can bring any special papers, fabric or images, stamped images on tissue paper stickers (not necessary but bring things you might like to use ) - good to have a zippered pouch for these.
- Glue stick (Uhu is a favorite brand)
- Waxed paper pieces to place in between pages (we will have extra)
- Stabilo-All black pencil, water soluble pencils or crayons such as Neocolor II, Woody, Derwent inkstense pencils in colors that you like.
- Waterproof black and white fineliner pens (Uniball Air, Uniball Signo),
- Washi tape, masking tape - you can wind several types around a plastic gift card to save space
- Small scissors
- Baby wipes in a ziploc bag
- 12 inch metal ruler

#### **Additional items when you have more room**

- Waterbrush and small watercolor kit
- Needle and embroidery thread or waxed thread
- Mini brayer
- Craft knife
- Squeeze fine liner bottles of acrylic paint
- Posca paint pens
- Matte medium (in small container such as travel squeeze container)
- White and black gesso (in small bottles)
- Stamps and stamp pad
- 6 inch metal ruler (for your travel kit)
- Mini-printer to print photos while travelling
